Project Description:

In addition to expanding the Mennonite Central Committee's administrative offices on this 8.5 acre site, this project included the development of missionary training and receiving facilities: four housing "pods", future apartments, a multi-level orientation center, accessible parking facilities and pedestrian pathways, innovative storm water management techniques, and non-traditional landscaping and site furnishings completed the sites improvements. Storm water management control facilities utilized best management practices to control and renovate the storm water runoff.

Challenges included topographic conditions, existing woodlands and wetland areas and the location of the campus within an already established Akron Borough neighborhood, which called for an "international village" context.
