Project Description:

This high volume, non-signalized intersection with no turning lanes provided very little visibility.

This project involved the widening and overlay of existing Lampeter Road to accommodate left turn lanes (in both the northbound and southbound directions) as the road approaches the intersection with Morningside Drive. A traffic signal was also installed at this intersection.

The project design included the widening and overlay of the roadway and its associated storm sewer system, adjacent driveway modifications, and bank removal to improve sight distance at the intersection. Cost of the project was \$330,000 and was completed in December 2002.
