Project Description:

This congested intersection with no turning lanes and poor stormwater drainage, had no sidewalks for pedestrians, and had limited right-of-way due to historic structures and existing businesses.

This project involved the widening of existing Village Road to accommodate left turn lanes on both the eastbound and westbound approaches of the Lampeter Road intersection. Traffic signals were replaced at the intersection, and curbs and sidewalks were installed through the Village of Lampeter. Cost of the project was \$2.2 million and was completed in November 2003.
